## Pink Ladies raise £18K for breast cancer charity

MORE than £18,000 was presented to Cancer Research UK from the region's Pink Ladies charity tractor run. Seventy tractors were decorated in pink and driven on a 20-mile course through Harleston and Pulham St Mary to raise money to help breast cancer awareness. The cheque was handed over at a special evening held in the barn of organiser Annie Chapman's Pulham Market home. She said: "We have had a lot of support from the people in the villages. Everyone knows someone

who has had breast cancer and there were quite a lot of women on the run who had suffered from the disease."

The presentation evening was also a reunion of the women drivers, some of who had learned to drive a tractor specifically to take part in the run.

Mrs Chapman, who is a member of the David Brown Tractor Club, said: "It is quite a hard act to follow but there is so much support for it that I don't think we will get away with not doing it next year. I would also really like to thank all the sponsors."
